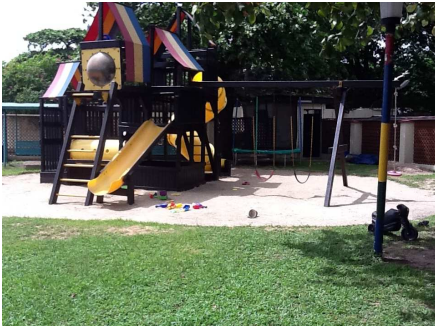
### 100 CLUBS

Shango is tuned for Dieball sails. (Skip Dieball is the designer of North M5 and Quantum lightning sails) The racing main and jib are new this fall (and have not seen big winds). The cruising main is 2 years old with a 1 year old jib. She has a brand new Dieball maxi chute (green), a two year old reaching chute (red white and blue), and 3 year old AP chute (green).
